The School Board is pursuing a staged investment plan to address our capital projects including the building of a new elementary school in a manner that prioritizes and addresses our needs through a responsible and beneficial plan for our district and community.

Last month, I asked for your support at an Edgmont Township meeting to support our proposed new elementary school. The new school will address development and growth where it is taking place - largely in Edgmont Township.
