

Title I Rose Tree Media School District

Title I is a non-competitive federal grant given to eligible schools. The term “noncompetitive” describes grants which are entitlements.

Funding is determined by different formulas, which are usually tied to the district’s need, as determined by the percentage of low-income students.

The United States Department of Education allocates funds to the PA Department of Education which distributes the grants to districts with qualifying schools.
