WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW – PLEASE REVIEW EACH ITEM

Students & Parents should enter on the CAFETERIA SIDE OF THE BUILDING. We will allow one parent to accompany the student to assist with pick-up.

Masks are REQUIRED. We also ask that you be respectful and socially-distance while in the building and while waiting to enter. Please be aware that we will manage capacity to ensure that everyone is safe.

Each student has a pile of materials. The materials are arranged alphabetically by the student's TEAM. It would be helpful for you to know the student's team assignment.

We encourage students to bring some type of BAG for their pile of materials.

If possible, please bring any forms that you need to return to us. This would include the updated emergency card and the blue and yellow technology forms that were included in the recent mailing. If this is not possible, we will collect these in the coming weeks.

Once the student has secured his/her pile of materials, he/she will check-out with a staff member. We will collect the sheet of paper with the student's name that is contained in the pile. Students will redeem this sheet of paper for a few Spartan goodies!

Students will complete their short loop through the building and exit back into the courtyard. The loop through the building is one-way in order to reinforce social-distancing.

Optional padded Chromebook cases will be available for purchase at check-out for \$25. We will accept cash OR checks made payable to RTMSD.

To ask a question

Click in the field "your name" and type your first and last name - you will only have to enter your name once. Click in the field "ask a question" and type your question, then press the enter/return key on your keyboard or click on the send arrow symbol. Click in the box "post as anonymous" for those questions you would like to post anonymously. The Moderator will not see your name associated with the questions when there is a checkmark in the box.

Additional Notes

The Moderator sees everyone's questions but you are only able to see your own under the "my questions" tab. The Featured tab includes, if any, comments by the Moderator.

If you are not able to attend live, we will do our best to record the session and to share with everyone later in the week.
