More than two thirds of the approximately 50,000 high scorers on the PSATs receive Letters of Commendation in recognition of their outstanding academic promise. Commended students are named based on a nationally applied Selection Index score.

The Board recognized National Merit Finalist students: **Leo Ouyang**, **Jingxi Sun**, and **Meixi Sun**. The National Merit Scholarship Program is an academic competition for recognition and scholarships. Of the 1.5 million entrants, some 50,000 with the highest PSAT Selection Index scores qualify for recognition in the National Merit Scholarship Program. 15,000 Semifinalists advance to Finalist standing based on their abilities, skills, and accomplishments.
